Class Policies

- Class will begin on time each week. When latecomers arrive, the class flow is disturbed and it's hard for the late arrival to get oriented.
- Parents please participate in the class activities. You are a very powerful role model for your child. I'm not concerned about your "musical competence". Your participation cues your child that it is safe, enjoyable, and important.
- Please don't carry on conversations with other adults during the class. Your focus and attention on class activities model attitudes of respect and enjoyment of music.
- Please respect this special time with your child and leave your cell phone behind.
- Please let me know if you want to bring a visitor to class. I welcome grandparents, extra parents, etc. but it can get overwhelming if there are too many visitors all at once.
- Thank you for keeping individual bottles, snacks, and toys out of the class area, since children are sometimes irretrievably distracted by the idea that food or toys are present.
- Thank you for keeping sick children at home. I am sorry to miss them in class, but you know how illnesses can travel through groups of children.
- Thank you for communicating with me. I am always eager to hear how music is being expressed and enjoyed in the life of your family. Feel free to let me know of any questions or concerns you might have.
- Thank you for telling your friends about the classes. Please feel free to give them my phone number, and either they or you can call me ahead of time for an invitation to visit the class with you!

Registration Policies

- Enrollment is on a first-come basis. The non-refundable registration fee covers the cost of our high-quality family materials and is due with the enrollment form.
- Tuition is due on or before the first day of class.
- There will be no credits for missed classes, however there *may* be an opportunity to make up a class if another session is not full.
